

MUHYIDDIN IBN ‘ARABI SOCIETY

Young Writer of the Year 2009

An award of US\$ 1,000 for an unpublished essay concerning the teachings of Muhyiddin Ibn ‘Arabi by an author under the age of 35. Deadline for entries: 3 June 2009

Criteria for entry:

- The author must be under the age of 35 on 31 December 2008.
- The essay should be the original work of the person submitting it.
- It must be unpublished at the time of entry, and be between 5,000 and 9,000 words in length.
- The work submitted must be in the English language, and should not be a translation of an essay published in another language.

Conditions of entry

- There will be three judges. In all matters the decision of the judges shall be final. The Society reserves the right not to award a prize if in the opinion of the judges no essay entered is of the required standard.
- The Society will have the right to publish the essay.
- Four copies of the essay should be sent to the Society at the address given. Submissions should be typed in double-line spacing, with the author’s name on the first page. These copies will not be returned.
- Please note that entries must be sent by post. Entries sent by fax or e-mail will not be accepted. Proof of postage is not proof of receipt.
